Strategic Direction #1: Building Capacity for Future Clinicians in Quality Improvement (C-QI) in Mental Health

- Provide mentorship for C-QI faculty to support scholarship and promotions
 - o Support Psychiatrist-in-Chiefs in identifying and developing faculty in C-QI position
 - o Integration within Department of Psychiatry faculty promotions faculty development
 - o Alignment with Faculty of Medicine emerging QI promotion criteria
- Create a co-learning opportunity for faculty through resident QI curriculum to support faculty QI professional development
- Expand QI exposure and engagement through annual CPPD Conference Day
- Recognize excellence in QI within the Department of Psychiatry through creation of a QI award (in addition to CPPD Award)
- Share QI activities within the department supporting implementation of Health Quality Ontario Mental Health Standards (e.g. Depression and Schizophrenia)

Strategic Direction #2: Supporting Lifelong Learning through Feedback from Data

- Identify sources of data and role for data analytics for mental health learners across hospital sites and utility for learning
- Understand the facilitators and barriers to using data to support lifelong learning within Psychiatry
- Building capacity in the use of data analytics and delivering feedback on data to support lifelong learning

Strategic Direction #3: Integrating Practice Improvement within CPD

- Deliver and evaluate CPD activities aligned with Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Competence by Design (RCPSC CBD)
